CARE & MAINTENANCE OF YOUR NEW VEHICLE WRAP



Follow These Tips To Keep Your Graphics Looking Their Best:

1. Wash Regularly

Wash whenever vehicle appears dirty. Contaminants allowed to remain on the wrap may be more difficult to remove. Rinse off as much grit as possible by spraying with water. Use a wet. non-abrasive cleaner and a soft, clean cloth or sponge. Rinse thoroughly with clean water. To reduce spotting, use a silicone squeegee or microfiber cloth to dry. Allow 48 hours after installation to clean the vehicle.

2. Automated Car Washes

Brush type car washes are not recommended as they can abrade the film, lift edges and dull appearance. Brushless washes are acceptable.

3. Pressure Washing

Although hand washing is preferred, pressure washing may be used under these conditions:

- Water pressure below 2000 psi
- Water temperature below 80
- Use spray nozzle with wide angle spray
- Keep nozzle at least 1 foot away and perpendicular

4. Difficult Contaminants

Soften difficult contaminants such as bug splatter, bird droppings, and sap by soaking for several minutes with hot, soapy water. Rinse thoroughly, then dry. Do not use rough scrubbing or abrasive tools. Use isopropyl alcohol for stubborn areas. Wash and rinse all residue immediately.

5. Store Indoors or Cover When Possible

Wrap films are degraded by long-term exposure to sun and atmospheric pollutants, especially on horizontal surfaces. When possible, store in a garage or a shaded area. If your wrap starts to discolor, immediately have a professional remove the wrap to avoid damaging the vehicle's paint. Standard waxes and polishes are acceptable to use on decals and graphics if they are smooth and glossy in appearance. If your film has a matte or textured finish do not use any polishing or wax products. Do not use abrasive polishes or cutting compounds on any films. Edges of films can be prone to lifting if rubbed often. When applying was apply from the center to the edges to avoid

Do not use any abrasive polishes or cutting compounds. Do not use any polishing or wax products on matte or textured films.
